The Iowa Department of Natural Resources in accordance with Subrule 567—64.2(9)c of the Iowa Administrative Code has approved your October 4, 2002 request for a variance from the Department Rule 567—64.2(9)b and Chapter 15.2.4.2.1 of the Iowa Wastewater Facilities Design Standards, which requires a minimum 5/8 inch opening for the mechanical screen. Based on the documentation presented by the design engineer, it is the determination of this Department that satisfactory justification has been presented to warrant the granting of a variance to the City of Walford for using a minimum clear opening of ½ inch for the mechanical screen.

This decision is based on our review of justification presented to support the request and our concurrence that the resulting project will provide substantially equivalent effectiveness as would be provided by technical compliance with the design standard on this issue.
