TITLE VIII SEASONS, LIMITS, METHODS OF TAKE CHAPTER 76 UNPROTECTED NONGAME [Prior to 12/31/86, Conservation Commission [290] Ch 16]

Chapter rescission date pursuant to Iowa Code section <u>17A.7</u>: 1/1/28 **571—76.1(481A) Species.** Certain species of nongame shall not be protected.

76.1(1) *Birds.* The European starling <u>(Sturnus vulgaris)</u> and the house sparrow <u>(Passer domesticus)</u> shall not be protected.

76.1(2) *Reptiles.*

a. Garter snake<u>Common garter snake (Thamnophis sirtalis)</u>.

b. Timber rattlesnake (Crotalus horridus) except in Allamakee, Appanoose, Clayton, Delaware, Des Moines, Dubuque, Fayette, Henry, Jackson, Jones, Lee, Madison, Van Buren, and Winneshiek Counties but not including an area of within 50 yards around of houses actively occupied by humans beings in those counties.

This rule is intended to implement Iowa Code sections <u>481A.38</u>, <u>481A.39</u>, and <u>481A.42</u>.
