NPDES Stormwater General Permit Public Notice Template

Information and Instructions

lowa law requires dischargers to provide public notice when seeking coverage under an NPDES stormwater general permit. The public notice must be published at least one day <u>at your own expense</u> in the newspaper with the largest circulation in the area where the discharge is located. To determine which newspaper has the largest circulation, ask a local newspaper or check the Iowa Newspaper Association (INA) at https://inanews.com/find-iowa-newspaper.

A template public notice wording is below for your convenience. This wording contains the minimum information that must be provided in the public notice. You **MUST** complete the blank portions with the specified information. You may add more information to the notice if you wish.

Proof of publication can be provided by either a clipping of the public notice with the name of the newspaper and date published, or an affidavit from the newspaper with the clippings attached to demonstrate fulfillment of the public notification requirement.
