

## **CLAYTON COUNTY ENHANCEMENT COMMITTEE FIVE-YEAR PLAN**

The Clayton County Resources and Enhancement Committee has established the following nine goals. Developed by local citizen input, these goals will serve to help coordinate REAP activity in the county for the next five years. These nine goals reflect several local environmental issues, resource needs and opportunities in Clayton County.

### **CLAYTON COUNTY REC GOALS**

1. To promote and increase lifetime environmental/conservation education by promoting awareness to environmental problems in the county.
2. Inventory, protect, improve, and expand wetland acres, streams and river habitats.
3. Inventory, protect and improve timber resources.
4. Inventory, monitor, and protect unique natural resources in Clayton County; e.g. prairie remnants, cold water streams, and cold air slopes.
5. Inventory, monitor, and protect unique historical and archeological sites.
6. Maintain, improve, and expand park facilities and historical sites in the county.
7. Coordinate, develop, and improve trail systems throughout Clayton County.
8. Promote programs that reduce, reuse and recycle.
9. Promote the protection of Clayton County's natural and historical resources in an effort to encourage tourism and economic development that are compatible with our unique landscape.
