PETITION FOR WAIVER

To obtain a waiver to an administrative rule adopted by the DNR a petitioner must provide comprehensive justification, which satisfies all of the criteria in Iowa Code section [17A.9A](#) and 561 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter (IAC) [10.4](#) and either 567 IAC [64.2\(9\) "c"](#), 567 IAC [43.3\(2\) "b"](#), 567 IAC [39.11](#), or 567 IAC [49.5](#).

Including but not limited to, the following criteria:

1. The application of the rule would pose an undue hardship on the person for whom the waiver is requested.
2. The waiver from the requirements of a rule in the specific case would not prejudice the substantial legal rights of any person.
3. The provisions of a rule subject to a petition for a waiver are not specifically mandated by statute or another provision of law.
4. Substantially equal protection of public health, safety, and welfare will be afforded by a means other than that prescribed in the particular rule for which the waiver is requested.

This form will assist you in providing the information that is necessary for the DNR to grant a waiver. The form must be submitted to the DNR and must contain an adequate amount of factual and concise information. The obligation rests with the petitioner to provide the evidence which establishes that all of the criteria are satisfied. Upon a request for a waiver, the DNR may require additional information to further support the waiver request.

Petitions will be comprehensively evaluated by the DNR. The DNR reserves the right to place any condition on the waiver. If information is not inclusive, concise, or does not adhere to the justifications and/or proof the petitioner has submitted, the waiver may be denied. Upon review, the DNR will grant or deny the waiver in writing.

Waivers are temporary unless evidence is shown that a temporary waiver would be impracticable. Once the waiver expires, the rule will be enforceable. There is no automatic renewal of a waiver. The term of a waiver is 1 (one) year, unless the permittee can justify a longer term or permanent time frame. The DNR may renew a waiver at its discretion. Please note that the DNR is not allowed to waive or alter a statutory requirement.

Petitioners must, within 30 days of submission of this petition, serve notice by certified mail of the pending petition, including a concise summary of its contents, upon all persons to whom notice is required by any provision of law. A written statement shall be provided to the DNR attesting that the required notice has been provided. The DNR may give notice to other persons.

PERMIT/PROGRAM

PETITIONER CERTIFICATION

The DNR shall grant or deny a petition for a waiver with 120 days of the receipt of the petition. Failure of the DNR to grant or deny a petition within the required time period shall be deemed a denial of that petition by the DNR. A waiver is void if the material facts are not true or if facts have been withheld. The DNR reserves the right to cancel a waiver at any time if the DNR finds that the facts as stated in the request are not true, material facts have been withheld, the alternative means of compliance provided in the waiver have failed to achieve the objectives of the statute, or the requester has failed to comply with the conditions of the waiver.
